

SELECTION GUIDELINES

AFGHAN REFUGEE YOUTH ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS 2018

Nominees will be aged between 12 & 24 Years. Over 18 years for Business Enterprise and Humanitarian/Community Categories.

Humanitarian & Community Service

The nominee will have acted as an advocate to individuals who would otherwise not have a voice and/or:

Provided essential support to those who have barriers to accessing services they need.

Provided direct and/or indirect support and service to Refugee and New Arrivals seeking material and personal assistance.

Educational Endeavour

The nominee will have completed High School level of education and/or have achieved one or

more of the following:

TAFE certificate at Level II or above in any area of study.

- Completed Trade Certification
- Completed a Degree level of study.
- Completed Post Graduate level of study.

Business Enterprise

The nominee will have set up an enterprise which is operating successfully.

Has developed links with other business networks to assist participation of other entrepreneurs.

Has developed and grown their small business activity and have provided employment opportunities to others.

Sport & Recreation

The nominee will have been engaged in their area of interest for at least 6 months. They will have developed their performance level and demonstrated commitment to excellence.

The nominee would have promoted a healthy lifestyle through participation in one or more recreational activities and encouraged others participation.

Arts & Culture

The nominee will have been participating in an area of Fine or Performing Arts and/or engaged in developing and/or promoting engagement in Cultural activities such as Dance, Handicraft, Language or other activity culturally appropriate activity.

These guidelines are issued by

Afghan Fajar Association Inc. and form part of the process for the selection of the various awards to selected nominees.

These guidelines may be varied at any time. The decisions of the Judging Panel are final.
